Nursery School

The class is open to potty-trained children who will be three years old by August 31, 2010, and meets Tuesday and Thursday mornings from 9:30 to 11:30. Introduction to colors, shapes, letters, numbers, printing and other skills are offered through music, play, and crafts.

Preschool

Open to potty-trained children who will be four years old by August 31, 2010, the class meets on Monday, Wednesday and Friday with a morning session from 9:15 to 11:45, and an afternoon session from 12:30 pm to 3.

The class prepares children for kindergarten success by developing fine and gross motor skills, listening skills, following directions, and taking turns. Emphasis is placed on shapes, numbers, letters, counting, and letter sounds. Through the use of songs and finger play, the children learn the days of the week, months of the year, holidays, and much more.

Transition Class

T-class meets Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:30 to noon and is open to potty-trained children who will be five years old by December 31, 2010, and have had preschool experience. This class is designed for children who miss the birthdate cut off for kindergarten, or who are not quite ready for kindergarten.

Class activities include review of colors, shapes, letters, numbers, and counting. Emphasis is placed on fine-tuning Kindergarten skills such as printing, following oral directions, using scissors, worksheets, and strong work on phonics and simple science experiments.

We have several parties and field trips during the year as well as several special visitors.
