Nursery School

This class is open to potty-trained children who will be three years of age by August 31. Class meets from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m. on Tuesdays and Thursdays. An extended class meets on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.

Basic introduction to colors, shapes, letters, numbers, use of scissors, and printing help children adjust to their first classroom experience in a safe and fun environment.

Some of the activities include visits from police and fire personnel, holiday parties, music, stories, rhythm instruments, class trips, and organized play. We strive to develop fine motor skills through use of manipulatives and gross motor skills through indoor and outdoor play.



Preschool

Preschool is open to potty-trained children who will be four years of age by August 31.

There are two classes meeting on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. The morning class runs from 9:15 to 11:45 a.m. The afternoon class runs from 12:30 to 3 p.m.

The goal of this class is to prepare children for kindergarten success by developing fine and gross motor skills, listening skills, following directions, and taking turns. Emphasis is placed on shapes, numbers, letters, counting, and letter sounds. Through the use of songs and finger play, the children learn the days of the week, months of the year, holidays, and much more. We have several parties and field trips during the year as well as several special visitors.
